

TRIBAL REVOLUTION VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

PLEASE READ BEFORE FILLING OUT THE VOLUNTEER FORM

Thank you for offering to volunteer your time at Tribal Revolution. Depending on the duty you are assigned to, you may be eligible for complimentary workshops, show tickets, or merchandise. Please be patient with us, as we are still firming up some details. Our new location is causing us to take a closer look at how we run things and make adjustments accordingly.

First, some guidelines:

Tribal Revolution has grown over the years into a true community event. We are looking for people who will support that community in a healthy and participatory manner. Because of this, we are not able to offer anyone the opportunity to volunteer as their only participation at Tribal Revolution. In order to be on the team, we need from each team player a commitment to the event. We are asking all volunteers to purchase at least two workshops during the weekend to be eligible to volunteer and receive complimentary workshops, show tickets, and other goodies.

The Jobs:

Workshop Monitor

- Check wrist bands and class rosters for attendance
- Ensure the room is stocked with water and the stereo system is working
- Attend to the needs of the instructors

For performing this duty, the volunteer will get to take the workshop for free.

*NOTE: if you are planning on purchasing any of the teacher package deals (Rachel Brice, Amy Sigil, Tempest, or il Troubadore) we have no way of refunding you for any workshop within this package that you monitor. Consider listing on the form only non-package workshops as ones you'd be interested in monitoring so you can get one of those as a gift for your volunteering.

House Assistants for Shows

- Ticket takers
- Ushers (Sat only)
- Door guards for stage and side entrances

Since these tasks allow you to see the shows, your compensation will be complimentary admission to the show you are working.

NOTE: If you are performing Thursday or Friday you will not be working that show. Show job assignments will come after we have determined who is performing at the Participant Showcases.

Stage Crew

- Stage managers
- Stage hands
- Sound tech
- Dressing room manager
- Videographer assistant

If the job you are assigned is in view of the stage then your show admission is free. If you are backstage or otherwise unable to view the performances because of your job, we will arrange some other compensation for you. As above, no volunteer will be assigned to work the same night s/he performs.

Tribal Revolution Office

- Checking-in of participants
- Workshop and show ticket sales
- Will-Call show ticket pickup
- Volunteer check-in
- Merchandise sales
- Answering general questions

The office will always be staffed by a member of Blue Lotus Tribe or other Registration Manager, but we need more hands at busier times. We have not yet determined what the compensation for working these shifts will be, but we will come up with a good way to thank you for your time.

Airport Runners

- Must be familiar with O'Hare and/or Midway airport's entrances, exits, parking, arrival and departure areas, and baggage claim.
- Must have a good understanding of Chicagoland's expressways.
- Must be willing to make an extra stop at Whole Foods in Palatine so our teachers may buy food.
- Must have reliable transportation that can fit up to three passengers and their baggage comfortably.
- Must provide proof of a valid driver's license and insurance.
- Must have a cell phone and be willing to give that number to the teacher(s) s/he is responsible for transporting.

Compensation is a captive audience with one or more of our fabulous instructors during your drive and a show ticket of your choice per run (max 2 runs).
